



## Blandy's duke of clarence sweet 3 years

The name refers to the English Duke of Clarence, who according to legend drowned in a butt of Madeira in 1478 — an anecdote that illustrates how prized Madeira has been at the English court for centuries. This full, sweet style remains a Christmas-time classic in the UK.

Deep amber in colour, with notes of dried fruit, caramel and spice. Full and sweet on the palate, with a rich, warming finish.
