Vintage Madeira 2009, made from the Tinta Negra grape. An authentic, traditionally aged Madeira in the versatile style, with the depth and complexity that only decades of cask ageing can bring.

Grape Variety	Tinta Negra – the island's most widely planted Madeira grape, versatile enough to approach any of the classic styles (dry to sweet), depending on vinification.
Drinking window	Ready to drink now — thanks to the nature of Madeira, this wine remains stable for many years, both in bottle and after opening.
Alc.	19.0%
Vinificatie	Traditional Madeira vinification: after fermentation, the Tinta Negra must is fortified (mutage) with neutral grape spirit, in a style that retains both body and lively acidity.
Rijping	Aged for more than 17 years using the traditional canteiro method: in oak casks in the naturally heated lodges (armazéns) of the wine house, giving the Madeira its characteristic oxidative character and remarkable longevity.
